Working with Children Check

The Department of Education has a policy that affects volunteers who come and work in our school. The policy states that all volunteers must have a working with children check (WWCC) number and provide 100 points of identification.

Our procedures for volunteers are as follows:

- All volunteers must sign in at the front office when they are on school grounds
- All volunteers must obtain a WWCC number and provide the front office staff at school with their clearance number (volunteers do not have to pay for this)
- All volunteers must provide the front office staff at school with 100 points of identification
- Any volunteer must be pre-arranged by the class teacher and approved by the Principal after the clearance number is obtained along with 100 points of identification

This includes classroom helpers, sports coaches and canteen volunteers.



The Partners in Learning Parent Feedback Survey

This term, our school will be participating in the *Partners in Learning* parent survey, another part of the Tell Them From Me suite of surveys (student, teacher and parent surveys) on student engagement. Running this survey will help our school understand parents' and carers' perspectives on their child's experiences at school. The survey is conducted entirely online on smartphones, iPads, tablets, laptops or computers. The survey will typically take 15 minutes or less to complete and is completely confidential.
