This week we are thrilled to take delivery of a Virtual Reality STEMShare Kit! STEMShare is an initiative that empowers schools with the technology tools to enable students to develop essential future focused Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) skills. All schools in NSW were given the opportunity to book one of the following kits for one term – Tablet Robotics, PC Robotics, 3D Printing, Filming, Virtual Reality and Coding. In addition to the kit, we have access to learning challenges, how to videos and support by STEMShare leaders.

3-6 Robotics and Coding

Our IT mentor, Ms Vicki Kempton, returns to JPS this Friday for a final robotics and coding workshop with Years 3 – 6. Over the term, Year 3 and 4 students have worked with WeDo2 kits and built race cars, buggies with trailers and dancing creatures. Years 5 and 6 have used the EV3 Lego Mindstorm kits and made snow sweepers, tractors and army tanks. With coding software they have been able to program these vehicles to perform a variety of tasks.

Sporting Schools

Our Term 3 Sporting Schools Program continues this week. The program is implemented on Friday afternoons between 1:50 – 3:10pm with each class participating in a 40 minute skills session with coaches from Skillzone.

Captain's Report

Welcome to Week 8.

Last Friday 3/4/5/6 enjoyed another Robotics session with Vicki Kempton. 5-6 built army tanks and we had to program them to move around a town mat. We also had to make them reverse park. To make these tanks turn corners we had to program the left motor to stop and leave the right motor on which would make it turn to the left. 3-4 used WeDo2 to build a buggy with a trailer and used block coding to make them drive. Building the robots is harder than programming because if you put the pieces in the wrong spot it won't fit together.

On Monday years 3-4 travelled to Beechworth with Mayrung, Blighty and Conargo for their excursion. We hope they are having fun.

Tomorrow, K-6 will be travelling to Berrigan to watch the Berrigan Public School Production 'Hairy Tale Rock'. We are looking forward to getting some tips for our own production later this year.

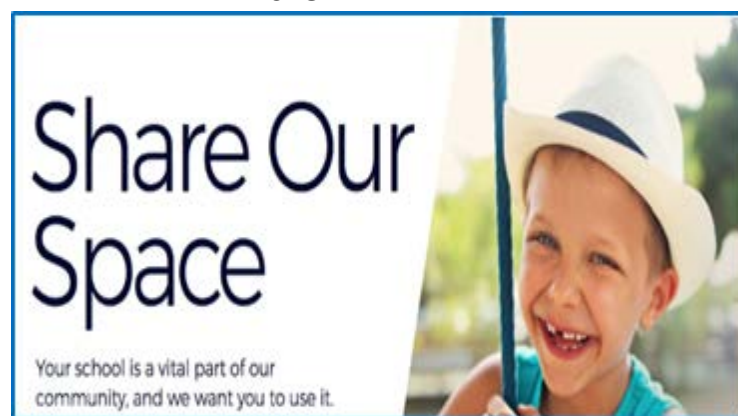
Upcoming Events (Term 3 Holidays)

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Housekeeping

Student Attendance

Parents and Carers are reminded that students are required, by law, to attend school every day that the school is open for instruction. Acceptable reasons for being absent include illness or minor injury, or attending medical appointments in another town. Medical certificates will be asked for if the number of absences for a student is causing concern. Please contact the school office via phone or email if your child is absent for any reason.

Working with Children Check

The Department of Education has a policy that affects volunteers who come and work in our school. The policy states that all volunteers must have a working with children check number and provide 100 points of identification. Our procedures for volunteers are as follows:

- All volunteers must sign in at the front office when they are on school grounds
- All volunteers must obtain a working with children check number and provide the front office staff at school with their clearance number (volunteers do not have to pay for this)
- All volunteers must provide the front office staff at school with 100 points of identification
- Any volunteer must be pre-arranged by the class teacher and approved by the Principal after the clearance number is obtained along with 100 points of identification

This includes classroom helpers, sports coaches and canteen volunteers.
